Guiding Principals

The school is concerned about the effects of smoking on the health of those who smoke and others who share the same environment.

Guidelines

- No smoking is permitted at Tapawera Area School, or on any activities involving pupils away from Tapawera Area School. This includes parents, employees and contractors and any other helpers. This includes inside vehicles.
- Notices will be displayed at school entrance ways informing everyone that the school is Smoke Free
- All prospective employees will be informed of the school's Smoke Free procedures
- All complaints regarding smoking will be investigated in the first instance by the Principal within 20 working days following the procedure laid down in the Smoke Free Environment Act 1990
